MEMORANDUM TO COUNSEL RE: Shawnta DeShields, et al. v. Kennedy Krieger
Institute, Inc.
Civil #L-02-3694

Dear Counsel:

On May 29, 2003, the Court held a discovery conference. This letter is to confirm the substance of the Court's decisions made during the conference. For the reasons stated on the record, the Court ruled as follows:

- (i) Kennedy Krieger shall produce all documents related to the merits of the case, save those for which Kennedy Krieger asserts a claim of privilege;
- (ii) on or before July 30, 2003, the parties shall submit a joint status report advising whether the relevant documents have been produced; and
- (iii) on or before August 29th, Plaintiffs shall submit a status report advising of their progress in reviewing the relevant documents.

After Plaintiffs have concluded their review of the documents, the parties shall meet face-to-face to fashion a proposed discovery plan, which they will submit to the Court. The Court will set a deadline for the submission of this plan after receiving the Plaintiffs' status report.

Despite the informal nature of this memorandum, it shall constitute an Order of the Court and the Clerk is directed to docket it accordingly.
